The Second Special Survey No.1 became due in June, 1919,  
and has been partly held.

Some damage through fire requires to be permanently repaired.

In December, 1920 the Surveyor at Rio de Janeiro was instructed to impress upon the Owners that the survey must be completed on the vessel's return, from a voyage on which she was then engaged.

The Rio de Janeiro Surveyor stated in June last that the vessel was at Buenos Aires, and that the Owners had informed him that on her return to Rio de Janeiro the matter would receive attention.

In a letter dated the 19th November the same Surveyor stated that he had been informed by the Owners that the vessel was just leaving New Orleans for Rio de Janeiro, and if the survey had not been held at New Orleans, arrangements would be made for it to be held on her arrival Rio de Janeiro.

On the 3rd instant a cablegram was sent to the Rio de Janeiro Surveyor to the effect that the survey must be completed on the vessel's arrival there. To this the Surveyor has replied that the Owners do not wish to retain the class.

In the circumstances, the Classing Committee who had the case before them on Tuesday, the 17th instant, decided to expunge the class with a red line (1.22.), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
