("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The class is subject to A2 from aft starboard side E.W. 11,29, 3,32 and 3,34 and the outer plates E.W.1,35 being specially examined at the next dry docking.

The Marseilles Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated.

The E.W. repairs, as above, have been specially examined and in the Surveyors' opinion the condition regarding same may now be removed.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 8,37 without special condition.
