This vessel being in efficient condition is eligible, in my opinion, to remain as classed without fresh record of Survey, and to have the notation of S.P. 2:2-36 and Carrying Wine in Portable Tanks. Subject to the E.W. repairs to the shell plating being specially examined on the next docking.
