Reverting to previous correspondence in this case the report of the General Examination held at Piraeus early in January has now received the consideration of the Committee, and postponement of the Special Survey until the ship's return to a Mediterranean port on completion of the present voyage to Cuba has now been approved.


Class has been continued by the Committee subject to shell plate No.10 in 3rd below sheer (fractured and doubled) (port side from forward) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next Drydocking, to No.4 DB tank not being used until the air pipes have been examined and dealt with as necessary and to the forward door of the main condenser being renewed by April, 1961.

The Main Boiler Survey, due in November 1960, was partly held and for a notation of MBS 1.61 the starboard boiler remains to be examined under steam and its safety valves adjusted.

No doubt you will let me know in due course at which port the Special Survey will receive attention.
