Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the Owner of the steamer "PETRA" accompanied by his Insurance Broker called here yesterday to say they had decided to sell this vessel for scrap to B.I.S.C.O. but that they wished to bring her timber cargo to Hull en route for the shipbreakers' yard.

It was agreed she would be towed for this purpose and accordingly I sent you a cablegram authorising the issue of a towage certificate provided on examination and essential repair you were satisfied the vessel was efficient for this short voyage with timber cargo.

It was agreed on all sides that the vessel was not to be granted class cover for the voyage, and accordingly I suggested a certificate on Rpt.10 making no reference to class, which conforms to our present practice.
