Reverting to your letter of the 2nd May last respecting the steamer "AUGSBURG", I think it well to inform you that I am now in receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyor at Dairen, dated the 3rd ultimo, to the effect that Lloyd's Agent, who is also acting as Dutch Consul, has informed the Surveyor that the German Consul has refused permission for the vessel to be handed over.

In the circumstances, it is not proposed to take any action regarding the issue of a Provisional Freeboard Certificate.
