F. With reference to your letter of the 20th and my reply of the 23rd January last relative to the assignment of freeboards to the steamer "AUGSBURG", I have to acquaint you I am now in receipt of a report from the Bremen Surveyors of a remeasurement survey recently carried out at their port on this ship, and I enclose herewith a copy of the same, together with the usual assignment letters, for the consideration of the Sec-Berufsgenossenschaft and shall be glad if and when the freeboards are approved you will arrange for the assignment letters to be issued.

I may add that when the freeboards are marked the Surveyors should verify the same and forward the usual verification of marking form to this Office in order that the necessary entry may be made in the Society's Register Book.
