this vessel in June 1st 1927. The Boiler Survey, which became
due in September 27, has been partly held, and to complete
this inspection the donkey boiler survey requires to be
carried out. A limit on the main boilers expired at the
end of June last.

The Rotterdam Surveyors reported in June last
the Steamer had left that port for Ancona without having
under survey, and in view of this and of the fact that
the period of grace expired at the end of June, the Owner
was asked to make definite arrangements for the Boiler Survey
to be completed and the repairs to the main boilers effected
before the vessel's arrival at Ancona, and also for the Second
Special Survey No. 3 to be held without further delay.

In reply the Owner stated that as the vessel
was chartered for a further voyage, he was unable to submit
her for inspection as desired, and that for reasons of
economy he was obliged to abandon the Society's class, having
in mind the severity of a Second Special Survey No. 3.

In the circumstances, the Classing Committee,
who had the case again before them on Friday, the 27th ultimo,
decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to
be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (7.28),
and the Owner has been informed accordingly.
