Foxhol v Arrasto
(Trawlers "PARGO" & "GORAZ")

With reference to your letter of the 24th April last, we enclose a copy of one which we have now received from Mr. van der Weel.

As you are aware, a notation of "Class Suspended" has been assigned in the case of the "PARGO". This ship, since the previous judgement has been confirmed, remains the property of Arrasto. We shall have to decide, therefore, whether we should now submit the case to the Classification Committee in order to have the class removed.

According to Mr. van der Weel's letter, however, there apparently still remains the possibility of yet more litigation.. Assuming that in the final analysis Arrasto are left in possession of the ship and there is a chance that they might reconsider their previous attitude and decide to keep the vessel in class, it might be better for us not to take any further action regarding classification in the meantime. If you have any information to furnish or comment to make in this connection, we shall be pleased if you will write at an early date.
