the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of

the Representative of the Companhia de Pesca do Centro de Portugal "ARRASTO" of Figueira da Foz, Portugal, attend on board the Motor Trawler "PARGO", in order to state his opinion about the strength of the construction of the stern frame and the landing of the A plates in way of same.

Upon examination it was found that the stern frame lower part had been welded instead of riveted as shown on the approved plan, also that part of the A plate landing to the keel plate in way of the thrust block was found cut away in order to avoid riveting in way.

The welding of the lower part of the stern frame was found good and the landing of the A plate found efficiently strengthened on the inner side and he is of opinion that the construction in way is of equivalent strength compared with the original riveted construction.
