Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steam trawler "PRINCESS JULIANA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case of this vessel under consideration and that in view of the vessel being laid up the Committee are agreeable to the 2nd Special Survey No.1 being postponed for the present in the event of it not being convenient to complete the same at an early date on the condition they usually require in the cases of vessels which are overdue for survey and are lying up indefinitely, viz :- that the survey be carried out before the vessel is again sent to sea, and that you undertake to have this done if she remain your property, and, should she be offered for sale, to inform intending purchasers that the class is allowed to remain subject to this being done.

I shall therefore be glad to learn that you are willing to agree to this condition and that you will immediately advise this Office of the name and address of the purchasers in the event of a sale being effected.
