Maschinenfabrik Augsburg-Nürnberg A.G. attend their Works at Augsburg on the 15th February, 1930, for the purpose of testing and inspecting one seamless starting air receiver of 400 ltrs. capacity, external diameter 440 mm., thickness of shell 17.8 mm., to the order of Messrs. Yokohama Dock Co. and destined for their m.v.No.179.

The air receiver has been examined throughout and was found in accordance with the approved plan. It has been submitted to internal hydraulic pressure of 60 Kg/cm<sup>2</sup> and was sound and tight at that pressure.
