The Special Survey No. 3 became due on this vessel in December 1924, and action has been deferred by the Classing Committee from time to time, in view of the fact that the vessel has been laid up in the James River, the late Owners having furnished the usual undertaking.

The vessel has now been sold to The Boston Scrap Metal Co., and has been towed to Baltimore for breaking-up purposes, and in the circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Friday, the 14th instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (~~5.26~~), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
