The Montreal Surveyor, writing on the 28th ultimo, states:-

"I have been in touch with the Owners of the s.s. "MANOA" and they
 "inform me that this vessel is now at Halifax completing loading
 "for Liverpool and London. After discharging she is to proceed to
 "Bremen for the repairs to the boilers to be carried out."

"I have advised them to write to the Surveyors at Halifax to this
 "effect and to request that a Certificate for this voyage be obtained
 "from them. A letter has also been sent to the Halifax Surveyors
 "notifying them of this advice."
