& part removed. One bunker bulkhead plate part removed. 6 lower deck  
beams. cropped & part removed.

Damage by Heavy weather. A quantity of rivetting in keel & in foreboard  
strakes adjacent at forefoot renewed. Forward length of fore bulge keel driven  
between rivets & rivets sprung, now repaired by removing the length of keel.  
straightening rivetting same. Bottom rudder cleaned examined & recoated.
