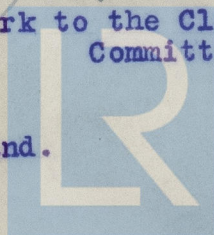
With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the motorship "RUTH", which vessel, it is understood, has become your property, I beg to acquaint you that under the Society's Rules the Modified Survey of the oil engines and the examination of the screw shaft became due in November, 1925, and neither of these inspections has yet been held. In addition the vessel became due for the Special Survey equal to a Half-Time Survey, and for the Donkey Boiler Survey in April last.

The Committee have hitherto deferred action in the matter as the vessel has been laid, but as the motorship has now been sold to your goodself, I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know what steps you propose taking for the overdue surveys to be held.
