Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the Motorship "RUTH", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their meeting to-day a report received from the Society's Surveyors at Copenhagen, from which it appears that the vessel has been examined in drydock after contact with ice, beaching and subsequent sinking.

The Surveyors state that they have made recommendations for repairs and that the vessel is now laid up, and in the circumstances the Committee have agreed to the vessel's class remaining undisturbed for the present, subject to the necessary repairs to the hull and machinery and the survey of the screwshaft and modified survey of the oil engines being carried out to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors before she again proceeds to sea.
