This vessel came under the survey of the Society's Aberdeen Surveyors in November last in connection with heavy weather damage repairs, when fees amounting to £4. 4. 0 were charged.

An account for this amount was rendered to the Owner, Mr. H.C.Baker, on the 3rd December last, but was returned by him with a statement that the vessel had been sold previous to the date of the account to Messrs. The Croft Steam Fishing Co. Ltd., of West Hartlepool.

The Aberdeen Surveyors subsequently confirmed the statement that the change of Ownership had taken place before the damage, and they accordingly rendered their account to the new Owners on the 9th December last.

Correspondence took place between the Aberdeen Surveyors and the new Owners, the latter pleading ignorance of the fact that the vessel was classed with this Society and of the Society's Rules.

The Hartlepool Surveyors were thereupon requested to call upon the new Owners, with a view to the outstanding amount being paid, but they stated on the 10th instant that the Directors of The Croft Steam Fishing Co. had decided to repudiate the liability and refuse to pay the account, and that they did not desire the class to be retained.


As a result, the new Owners were informed on the 15th instant that the case would be submitted to the



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Committee on the 22nd instant, when instructions would doubtless be given for the class to be withdrawn from the Register Book as provided for in the Rules if the outstanding account were not settled by that date.

As no reply or remittance was received, the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Tuesday, the 22nd instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Register Book, on account of non-payment of fees due.
