

Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the Steam Trawler "SAVARIA", which vessel has recently become your property, I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them the correspondence which has recently taken place between the Society's Surveyors at West Hartlepool and your goodself respecting the fees which are outstanding in connexion with the survey which took place on the Trawler at Aberdeen in November last.

With regard thereto, I have to draw your attention to the fact that, according to the Society's Rules, the vessel is liable to have her class withdrawn or expunged from the Register Book in the case of non-payment of any fees chargeable, and in view of this matter having now been standing over for so long, I have to say that the case will be submitted to the Committee on Tuesday next, the 22nd instant, and I have no doubt that unless the fees in question have been paid by that time the Committee will give instructions for the class to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book.
