Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th instant with reference to the recent Damage Survey of the steam trawler "SAVANIA", and with regard thereto beg to draw your attention to Page 4, Section 22, Paragraph 2 of the Rules and Regulations of this Society, which states that "all repairs of Ships or Machinery required at Ports where there is a Surveyor to this Society, in order to their obtaining a Character in the Register Book, or to their retaining the Characters assigned to them therein must be carried out under the inspection, and to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors. Ships or machinery repaired at Ports where there is no Surveyor to this Society must be surveyed by one of the Society's Surveyors at the earliest opportunity".

This paragraph will no doubt make it clear to you how this Society came to be interested in the Survey.
