The S.S.No.1 has been completed, it has been recommended the vessel have fresh record of survey 9-38. subject to 45 fathoms of chain cable of correct size & test being placed on board at first opportunity, and notation of S.S.No.1 with date.

REPAIRS:- No.1 & 2 hatch coaming stiffeners renewed.  
No.3 hatch, aft coaming stiffener renewed.  
About 20 hatch cleats renewed.  
About 40 wood hatch covers renewed.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree the freeboards given on certificate No. 8779 dated 25th. November 1935. is returned herewith.

Section 48 (4) of the Abolition of Feudal Tenure etc. (Scotland) Act 2000

1000 YTD at Benjamin's Landing

Benjamin's Landing is a small settlement of about 100 people, situated on the south coast of Scotland. It is a typical fishing village, with a small harbour and a few shops. The settlement is owned by the local authority, and the land is held on a long lease. The lease is for 100 years, and it is due to expire in 2021. The local authority is considering whether to renew the lease, and it is seeking advice from the Scottish Government.
