With reference to Circular No. 1518, regarding the issue of new freeboard certificates in the cases of vessels changing their name and/or Port of Registry, I beg to advise you that, so far as has been ascertained, there is only one case of this kind in Bombay at present.

The Steamer " Indira " 637 tons gross No. 73864 in the Register Book has changed her Port of Registry from Newcastle-on-Tyne to Bombay, but still carries the original Freeboard certificate numbered 86129 dated April 13th 1926.

The Owners have submitted that, as the Freeboard Certificate does not bear the name of the Port of Registry, there appears to be no necessity to renew the certificate.

I should be glad, therefore, to receive instructions regarding this matter.
