This vessel is expected in the Mersey in about 2/3 week's time to undergo extensive repairs and survey by Messrs. Grayson, Rollo & Clover Docks, Ltd., Birkenhead.

The arrangements made between Mr. Larilnov, Eng-Captain, U.S.S.R. and the Repairers are stated to be as follows:-

Vessel to be dry docked and opened up for examination, recommendations for repairs to be made by a Classification Surveyor, all work to be carried out to classification requirements and certificates to be furnished on completion of the work.

The Repairers have discussed the case with the writer and it was agreed that if no plans are available shewing scantlings they will be ascertained and the vessel undergo the full rule requirements for a vessel 24 years old, also that all classification and repair fees shall be paid by the Repairing Company.

As no particulars of the vessel are in the Register Book, I shall be glad to learn if any can be furnished from the London Office for guidance.

It is also stated that a second vessel may go to Manchester for repairs and that three others will come to the U.K. for repairs and survey.
