The Cast Iron Steam Cylinder, having been tested to 200 lbs. per square inch and the Cast Iron Hydraulic Cylinder 2,240 lbs. per square inch were stamped accordingly. The vessel was also tested to 300 lbs. per square inch with satisfactory results.

On completion of erection the engine was tried under pressure and also with the hand gear and was found satisfactory.
