Ltd., Paisley, attend at their works on the 30th May, 1949, for the purpose of inspecting and testing One Vertical Duplex Ballast pump 8" x 8" x 8", No. 21419 and intended for Messrs. Mercantile Marine Engineering & Graving Dock Ltd. Anvers, and intended for S.S. "GEORGIJ SEDOV" 1538 gross tons of Archangel.

The steam cylinder was tested by hydraulic pressure to 440 lbs per square inch and the pump end was tested by hydraulic pressure to 200 lbs per square inch with satisfactory results.

The pump was subsequently tried on the maker's test bed and found in order.

For purposes of identification the pump was stamped:-
