I am informed by the Principal Surveyor, New York, that this vessel has recently been dry docked at Baltimore, and that the Surveyors were given to understand she had been sold and re-named "ESSO BELGIUM", also that it is the intention of the new Owners to withdraw the ship from this Society's Class.

I shall therefore be obliged if you will enquire of Messrs. Esso Standard (Belgium) and let me know what is the position.

It is thought well to add that certain information regarding the quality of the steel is desired so that the necessity for fitting an additional strap in the bottom may be considered, and the Principal Surveyor, New York, is endeavouring to obtain the chemical properties of the steel used.
