REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR *S.S. No 1. Vessel placed in drydock, bottom Keel and rudder cleaned examined and coated. the hold, peaks, engine boiler space, and bunkers cleared and all ceiling lifted. The decks, masts, rigging, hatches, ventilators, Steering gear, hand pumps and connections and general equipment were examined. The chain cables were ranged and examined.*
