This vessel which was built in 1918 as an Admiralty Castle Type Trawler under British Corporation Supervision has been ^{partly} surveyed for classification by the Southampton Surveyors.

The Machinery boiler & screw shaft have been opened up & examined & found satisfactory. To complete the survey the machinery requires to be tried & the safety valves adjusted under steam.

It is submitted that this vessel is eligible for THE RECORD. L.M.C. 8.20. Subject to the safety valves being adjusted & the machinery tried under steam.
