In reply to your enquiry, we have been in communication with the Superintendent for Messrs. H. Markham Cook, Ltd., Grimsby, who informs us that the vessel had been sold on 29th May, 1947, through Messrs. Gibson, Johnson, Ship-brokers, Hull, to Drum Fishing Co., Ltd., 25, Rutland Square, Edinburgh, and that the vessel left Grimsby for Leith on 16th June, 1947.

The vessel was seen whilst on the Slipway at Grimsby for a few hours on 16th July, 1946, when a provisional examination of the under-water parts for repairs were made.

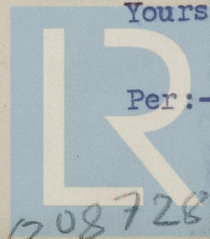
Under the circumstances it is regretted that the vessel was stated to have been under survey for Special Survey No.3 and L.M.C.
