


In reply to the enquiry contained in your classing letter of the 12th instant respecting the case of the Steam Trawler "DANE", our report No. 50424, we beg to confirm that the bottom and rudder have been examined and that the bottom has been coated.

Further, in addition to the items mentioned in the report, the tunnel space, ventilators, sounding pipes and mast wedges require to be examined, and in addition, the repairs recommended by us, there remains to be dealt with permanent repairs to the engine and boiler casing referred to in Liverpool report No. 113226, and it is regretted that this was not made clear in our report.
