This unclassified vessel was built at Lubeck in 1907 and was then classed ~~100A~~ 100A with the Germanischer Lloyd.

Plans of Midship Section, Longitudinal Section and Decks have been forwarded by the Trieste Surveyors for consideration, together with a First Entry Report.

The scantlings and arrangements as shown on the plans ^{and F.E. Report.} have been examined and found to be in accordance with or equivalent to the Society's requirements for the Class 100A.

It is submitted the Trieste Surveyors be informed that, provided the requirements of the Rules for Vessels Not Built under Survey be complied with, the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100A. If it is desired that the figure '1' be added to the vessel's class, full particulars of the equipment on board should be submitted for consideration.

It is further submitted, the Surveyors should be advised by telegram, in accordance with their telegraphed request, that the scantlings are acceptable for Class 100A.
