With reference to your letter of the 24th December last we have to say the vessel has now been placed in drydock, the shell plating drilled and the structure examined throughout.

Hull plans have been prepared by the local shipyard and the scantlings shown therein checked by us.

The vessel has generally been found in good condition except for a number of minor items now being dealt with. At the same time it is proposed to effect a conversion to oil fuel burning carrying oil in Nos. 2 & 3 double bottom tanks. Plans of the proposed arrangements, also machinery particulars will be submitted in due course, together with reports 8 & 9.

In the meantime plans of midship section, profile and decks, together with a First Entry Report on the hull are submitted herewith for consideration.
