Dear Mr. Sladden,

The "WINSTON CHURCHILL" ex "Empire Eddystone" has recently been under survey at this port for Special Survey and O.F. conversion. Our report (No.35240) on the case has been forwarded today under separate cover, together with the First Entry Report and plans.

You will note from the Register Book that the working pressure of the main boilers is given as 200 lbs per sq.inch, whereas that given in the First Entry Report is 220. In the absence of a qualifying note in the Special Reasons List (we haven't the deferred reports in our possession) it is apparent that an error, made when particulars were first entered, has been repeated in subsequent editions of the Register Book. As there seemed no doubt of this, Mr. Lundgren has taken the working pressure at 220 for the purposes of his survey.

Mr. Lundgren apologises for the delay in writing his report; he has been hard-pressed of late.
