As a result of a survey carried out by the Gothenburg Surveyors on the 20th March last, the Committee have continued the vessel's class subject to fractures in sheerstrake, deck in way of deckhouse front (port and starboard), in sheerstrake in way of freeing ports forward of midship deckhouse and in sheerstrake in way of aft end of recess for gangway (starboard side) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the end of next month.


I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly, and ascertain and let me know what arrangements they propose to make for the above items to be dealt with.

The vessel's class has also been continued subject to the propeller being specially examined and dealt with at the next drydocking, before the end of May, 1963, and the Owners' intentions regarding this matter will also be appreciated.
