

I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for DAMAGES, stated caused by heavy weather during voyage between Halifax - Kristiansand on the 5th - 17th March, 1963.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

Damages now found:-

- 1. Sheerstrake found fractured in way of freeing ports port and starboard about 7 metres forward of midship deckhouse for a length of about 2". See sketch.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed ~~with~~ without fresh record of dry docking, subject to fractures in shelter deck in way of deckhouse front, port and starboard, and to fractures in sheerstrake in way of freeing ports forward of midship deckhouse and to fracture in sheerstrake in way of aft end of recess for gangway, starboard side, being permanently repaired at earliest opportunity, but not later than end of May, 1963, and also subject to all other conditions at present attached to the ship's class being dealt with as previously recommended.

(Where conditions of class are recommended to be retained, imposed, amended or deleted, particulars must be stated above and on the interim certificate.)




As a temporary repair a hole has now been drilled at the ends of the fractures.

2. Sheerstrake found fractures at the aft end of the recess for the gangway on starboard for a length of about  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". See sketch.




As a temporary repair a hole has been drilled at the end of the fracture.

3. Shelter deck found fractured port and starboard in way of forward end of midship deckhouse. Each fracture about 1 feet long. See sketch.



As a temporary repair the end of the fractures were drilled. It was also arranged cement boxes to be fitted by the crew.

4. Longitudinal deckhouse side port and starboard fractured in way of door openings at lower end. Insert plates now fitted as per sketch.
