The undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. Nydqvist & Holm AB. Trollhättan, attend at their works for the purpose of examining and testing one five cyl. 2 S.C.S.A. auxiliary Diesel Engine, type K55E, No. I43I, intended for the motorship "Helga Smith".

The engine has been built under full survey in accordance with the Rules of the Society, materials and workmanship are good.

On completion, the engine was tried in shop under working conditions with satisfactory results.

For purposes of identifications the undermentioned parts were stamped thus:-

The engine has been despatched to Stockholm for fitting on board the vessel and is eligible, in my opinion, to be fitted onboard in a vessel classed to this Society, subject to plans and torsional vibration characteristics being approved.
