I now beg to confirm the following cables exchanged between us regarding the above steamer:-

Our cable dated 15/1/57 reading as follows:-

"GUMHURYAT MISR NOW LYING AFLOAT AT SUEZ UNDER SURVEY FOR HULL MACHINERY DAMAGE STOP OWNERS APPLIED FOR DAMAGE AND CLASSIFICATION SURVEYS STOP LLOYD'S AGENTS SUEZ APPOINTED SURVEYOR SAMI ANDRAWIS FOR DAMAGE REPORT STOP INTERIM CERTIFICATE REQUIRED FOR CLASSIFICATION STOP SEQUESTRATOR LLOYD'S REGISTER REQUEST AUTHORITY TO APPOINT HIM FOR CLASSIFICATION SURVEY AND FUTURE SURVEYS STOP CABLE REPLY URGENTLY ALEXANDRIA OFFICE".

Your reply dated 16/1/57 reading as follows:-

"GUMHURYAT MISR REURCAB TODAY SAMI ANDRAWIS NOT ACCEPTABLE TO COMMITTEE FOR CLASSIFICATION SURVEY."

Our cable of the 17/1/57 reading as follows:-

"REURCAB SIXTEENTH SEQUESTRATOR REQUEST YOUR SUGGESTION SURVEYORS FOR CLASSIFICATION SURVEYS SUEZ PORT SAID".

Your telegram dated 17/1/57 as follows:-

"REURCAB SEVENTEENTH COMMITTEE PREPARED TO TRANSFER EXCLUSIVE SURVEYOR TO CANAL ZONE PROVIDED THEY RECEIVE SATISFACTORY GUARANTEES COVERING HIS SAFETY AND WORKING CONDITIONS".

The Owners at Alexandria, with the consent of the Sequestrator, have contacted us and they requested Mr. Haniotis to proceed for Suez to survey the above vessel for classification purposes, and we have accordingly cabled you on the 22nd January 1957 as follows:-
