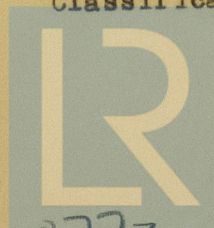
According to the records in this Office the present Continuous Survey cycle is not yet complete as the following items have not yet been examined:-
