Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 23rd instant from which it is noted that you have purchased the Steam Tug "MAURICE" subject to inspection.

The position of this vessel so far as the Society is concerned is that her class has been suspended because of the fact that she is very badly overdue for Periodical Surveys required by the Rules. A certificate for the voyage home could therefore not be issued under the aegis of this Society, more particularly as we have no Surveyor in Mauritius.

It is possible, of course, that Lloyd's Agents there would be able to appoint a Surveyor to issue you with some form of certificate which might satisfy the Underwriters but they would not be permitted to appoint such a Surveyor to act on behalf of Lloyd's Register.
