I, the undersigned, do hereby certify, that I did, at the request of Messrs Ireland, Fraser & Co., Ltd., Lloyds Agents at Port Louis, Mauritius, survey on the 13th and 18th November, 1952, the boiler of S.T. "Maurice" in all its accessible parts and have to report as under:-

Exterior examined as far as practicable. Lagging not removed. Condition good.

Interior good.

Furnaces, Port & Starboard good, Centre furnace seven rivet heads built up at bottom front, otherwise good.

Combustion chambers and tubes good.

Mountings good.

This boiler is in a fit and proper condition to carry safe working pressure of 130 lbs per square inch, at which pressure the safety valves have been floated and set in my presence on the 18th November, 1952.

Size of compression rings - Port $\frac{3}{8}$ ", starboard 7/16".

I recommend that the record of B.S. dated November 1952 be made in the Register Book.
