I, the undersigned, do hereby certify, that I did, at the request of Messrs Ireland, Fraser & Co., Ltd., Lloyds Agents, at Port Louis, Mauritius, survey on the 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th and 18th days of February, 1952, the S.T. "Maurice" whilst lying on Keel Blocks in Stevenson Dry Dock and report under:

Reference Survey Report of 8th November, 1951.

Hull Port Side - "C" & "D" Strakes.

Doubling fitted over landings of 3, 4 & 5 plates. Size doubling plates 24'-0" x 1'-0" x 5/16", jugged in way of landing, welded with 3 runs welding and tack welded  $\frac{3}{4}$ " holes. Adjacent rivets caulked.

Starboard Side "B" Strake, 3rd and 4th Plates.

Doubling 3'-6" x 2'-6" x  $\frac{3}{8}$ " welded over plate with runs of welding and tack welded  $\frac{3}{4}$ " holes. Adjacent rivets caulked.

Rudder Pintles.

All removed, skimmed on lathe and built up by Quasi Arc welding process and refitted, 1/16" play in bush. When completed, the rudder swung freely by hand.

These repairs having been carried out to my satisfaction, I recommend that the record of Dry Docking 2-52 be made in the Register Book.

The vessel retains her class.
