(agreed) On 21.4.60 the Buenos Aires Surveyors advised that the Owners had applied to the Naval Base at Puerto Belgrano for a drydock and the Authorities had promised a date for the end of 1960. On 29.4.60 the Buenos Aires Surveyors were instructed to inform the Owners that the Committee could not contemplate so long ago an extension, in view of the fact that the ship was last seen in drydock as long ago as 7.58 and the Owners were to state a better proposal.

proposal The Buenos Aires Surveyors are now advised by the Owners that provisional arrangements have been made to drydock the ship about the end of 7.60 (24 months after last examination in drydock). Arrangements for Special Survey (or General Examination) are not stated.
