Nature of Survey


The class of this vessel is subject to the bow plating, etc., damaged through encountering ice, being further examined at the next dry docking and repaired as considered necessary.

The St. John, N.B. Surveyor now reports that owing to heavy weather some rivets were found leaking on the port side in way of No.1 tank. Temporary repairs have been effected and the Surveyor recommends the vessel be placed in dry dock for permanent repairs at a convenient opportunity.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, subject to permanent repairs being effected in way of No.1 tank at a convenient opportunity, as recommended and subject as above.
