Re First Entry Report Hull & Machinery s.s. "LENNEP"

Having reference to First Entry Reports on the steamer s.s. "LENNEP" Act. Ges. Neptun Rostock No 344 and your inquiry respecting the approved plans of this vessel.

I beg to advise you that the completed approved plans of the Hull and Boilers as well as tests certificates of Forgings and Casting were forwarded to your address under separate cover on the same date as the reports were sent viz:- 23 March last I personally handed them in at the Post Office on that date

For your information I have to state that the difference between the Lennep and the steamers "HOF" First Entry Report 13953 and s.s. "U L M" First Entry Report No 14030 is that the Moulded Depth in "Lennep" is 4 inches greater than in the s.s. "H O F" & "U L M" and the length is 18 ft longer, the arrangement of bulkheads are as follows in the s.s. "LENNEP" as compared with the S.S. "H O F" & "U L M" is that the After Hold is 4 frame spaces the Engine & Boilers spaces 5 frame spaces and Fore Hold 1 frame space longer.

I do hope that the approved plans for this vessel has in the mean time reached your address as it would not be prudent at present to ask for copies which however could be obtained at some later date, There are no duplicates of the approved plans at this Office.

You do not mention having received either the Hamburg First Entry Reports nor the Approved plans of the S.S. "KRONENFELS" forwarded to your address on the 19th March last.
