The machinery of this vessel was constructed in 1914-15 at Rostock & from entries in Mr Köhler's journal (Hamburg) it appears the engines & boilers were examined during construction but the boilers were not tested nor was the machinery fitted on board under his supervision.

A 1<sup>st</sup> entry report was forwarded in March 20 this was made up from one on a sister vessel & from entries in the Surveyor's journal, & was found to meet the requirements of the Rules.

The machinery & boilers have now been examined throughout at Newcastle the screw shaft examined the steam pipes tested the scantlings verified as far as practicable & the machinery put in good condition.
