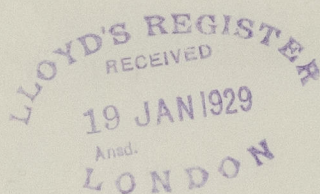

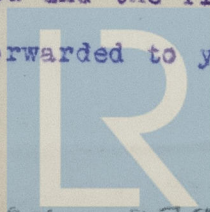

Dear Sir,

In compliance with your letter of the 17th instant I beg to forward herewith a report on Form 11b showing details of the alterations now being made to the steamer "GEDDINGTON COURT", together with an application form duly signed.

It is understood that the Board of Trade Surveyor is forwarding the revised tonnages etc., to London today for approval.

The Superintendent states that the vessel is sailing for Vancouver on Tuesday next, possibly early tide. It is desired in view of the urgency of the case that the amended freeboard assignment particulars may be wired as soon as possible, and the new freeboard certificates forwarded to this office.
