which was in the Tama Dry Dock, Tama, on the 28th February, 1941, and upon examination, found the bottom and all outside parts below the load water line, in good condition, fair wear and tear excepted, and free from breakage or damage, with the following exception:-

Stern frame was found fractured at the sole piece and has now been satisfactorily repaired by electric welding, but, it is recommended that it be specially examined at the next dry docking.
