Dear Sir,

S. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 16th instant, from which it is noted that, for reasons of uniformity, you have decided to transfer the classification of your Motorship "ZULIA" from this Society to the Germanischer Lloyd, and I have to say that, in the circumstances, the Committee have given instructions for her class to be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
