
With reference to my letter of the 28th ultimo respecting the motorship "ZULIA", I have to acquaint you I am in receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyors at Hamburg in which they state they have been informed by the Owners that the vessel is at present engaged in the coasting trade in the Caribbean Sea and that she is not expected to return to Europe in the near future. It is also intimated that it is proposed to have the Modified Survey of the Oil Engines carried out at Willemstad during April and that the Owners have informed their Representatives at that port to make arrangements accordingly.
