

In reply to your letter of the 26th. ultimo, we beg to inform you that we have received the four Load Line Certificates for the steamer "PUNGUE"

The error in the assignment letter had been noted and amended and the freeboards have been correctly marked.

The port of Register is now Lobão not Beira as previously reported also the gross tonnage is now 4017.87 tons instead of 3992.87 and the certificates have been amended accordingly.

We wish to state, however that the Load Line Certificates for the Motor Trawler "SANTA PRINCEZA" despatched on the 9th. Feb. have not yet arrived.
